TODAY'S PRIMARY TEXT

John 1:29, The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

THE BACKSTORY BEHIND THE NICKNAME

1. **The** _____

Genesis 22:7-8, "The fire and wood are here...but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?"⁸ Abraham answered, "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son."

Genesis 22:13, Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son.

Exodus 12:3-13, Tell the whole community of Israel...to take a lamb for his family, one for each household...The animals you choose must be year-old males without defect...slaughter them at twilight...Take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of the houses...¹²"On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn—both men and animals—and I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt. I am the Lord. ¹³The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt.
